Accessories Precautions

The GPS antenna is located in the dashboard. Metallic front or side window tinting can seriously degrade or obstruct GPS reception.

Signal noise from devices such as radar detectors, vehicle tracking devices, remote starters, and additional amplifiers can disrupt the navigation system. If you install any such item, install it away from the navigation display and antenna.

Important Safety Information

WARNING

Using the navigation system while driving can take your attention away from the road, causing a crash in which you could be seriously injured or killed.

Only operate system controls when the conditions permit you to safely do so.

Avoid focusing on the screen or manually operating the system controls while driving. Certain on-screen controls are disabled when driving; however, most of the voice commands continue to function. Pull to the side of the road if you need to devote more attention and time to look at the screen or access additional menus. Route guidance may conflict with street closures, road construction, detours, and out-of-date map data.

The system itself may also have limitations. Verify route information by carefully observing roads, signs, and signals. Always use your own judgment and obey traffic laws.

Using Voice Commands

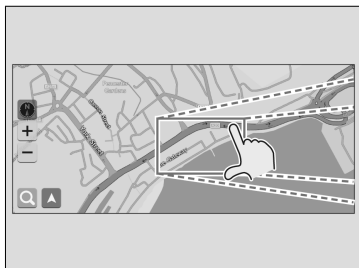
When you see  in this manual, voice commands are available for that feature.

Touchscreen Operation

Long Tap: Touch and hold the screen with your fingertip until you release your finger from the screen to scroll the map toward your fingertip.

Flick: Flick with your finger to scroll the map according to the movement of your finger.

Slide: Move your finger slowly across the screen to scroll the map.



Zoom In/Out: Open or close your fingers on the screen in a pinching motion to zoom in or out of the map.

Alternately, you can touch the screen twice with one finger to zoom in, or once with two fingers to zoom out.

HOME Screen

The system displays various functions from the HOME screen. Press the  (Home) button at any time to return to the main HOME screen.

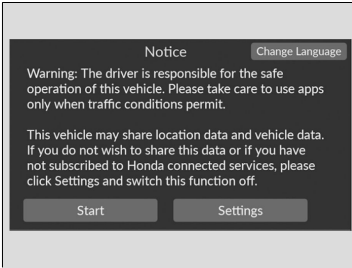
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Start-up

At Initial Start



- [1] Select **Start**.
- [2] Select **Navigation**.
 - » The map screen or navigation tutorial screen is displayed. If the navigation tutorial screen is displayed, select **Exit**.
 - » When you want to display the navigation top screen, press the  (Back) button.

Navigation tutorial is displayed at initial start. You can display the tutorial from the main menu at any time.

Adjust the navigation guidance volume.

Map Options

You can turn on/off the information displayed on the map, such as traffic information, congestion information, POI, Breadcrumb, Landmark, and switching between Day and Night modes.

Changes the route settings and shows the details of the current route.

- **Voice Guidance Language:** Lets you set the language for voice guidance.

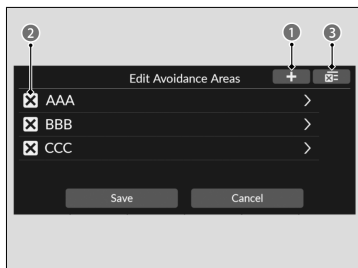

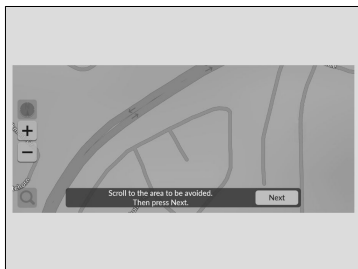
Avoidance Areas: Allows you to avoid specific roads or areas.



• **To add avoidance areas:**

- [1] Select **+** (1) to set the label and the area.
- [2] After searching for the area, select **Next**, trace the map on the screen by finger touch to select the area to be avoided and then select **Avoid** and **Save**. To edit the saved content, select Added Records.

- **To delete:** Select **X** (2). To delete all records, select (3).



Recent: Edits recent destinations.

Downloaded Places*1: Edits downloaded places.

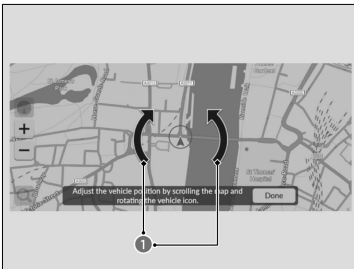

Adjust Vehicle Position

📍 ▶ **Navigation** ▶ ▶ **Settings** ▶ **Adjust Vehicle Position**

Manually adjust the current position of the vehicle as displayed on the map screen if the position appears to be incorrect. Make sure the vehicle is in Park.



- [1] Scroll the map to position the arrowhead at your correct position.
- [2] Select arrow icons (1) to position the arrowhead in the correct direction the vehicle is facing.
- [3] Select **Done**.

An apparent position error can occur where buildings, tunnels, and other objects block or reflect GPS signals, forcing the system to use “dead reckoning” to determine your location and direction.

Using this function to adjust vehicle position is not recommended. When the system reacquires a GPS signal, it will automatically place the vehicle in the correct location.

- When you purchase a vehicle, check its Database Version and update the map data if necessary.
- Updates navigation map data via Wi-Fi or USB flash drive.

To use this function, connect this navigation system to the internet via Wi-Fi device.

 **Online Services** ► **P.13**

Available map data will be updated at least once a year until 14 years from the vehicle's date of manufacture.

You can update your map data free of charge until 7 years after the date of manufacture of the vehicle, after which there will be a charge for updates until 14 years after the manufacture date.

Please ask your Honda dealer if you have any questions about the date of manufacture.

 For larger updates, please put the car in ignition to prevent battery drain.

 The Full Map Update via USB may take up to one hour. Please do not turn off the ignition while updating the map. It may cause problems.

 Please update the Full Map via USB at least once every two years.

 Otherwise the information on the "Find Place <POI>" feature of voice recognition will not be updated, causing inconvenience.

How to Update via Wi-Fi

The Home Region Map and Desired Region Map can be updated via Wi-Fi.

See the Owner's Manual for details Wi-Fi settings.



Due to the huge amount of data traffic, map updates should always be done via the Wi-Fi Hot Spot. Please do not update via mobile phone.

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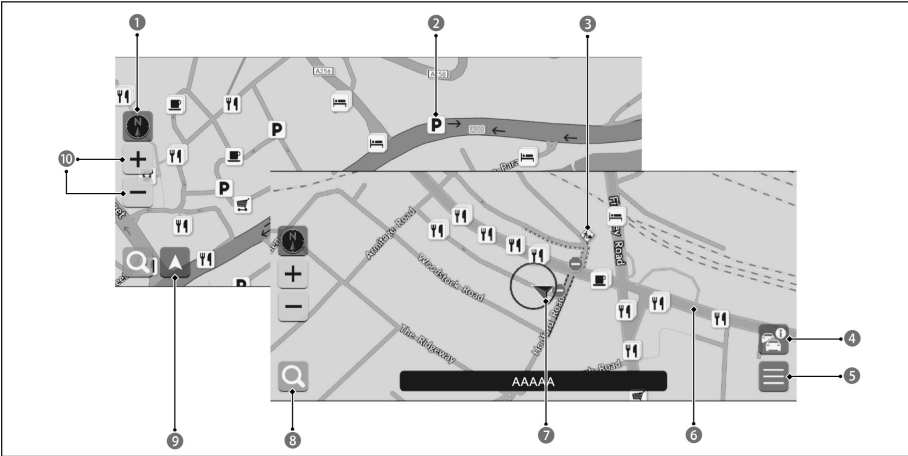

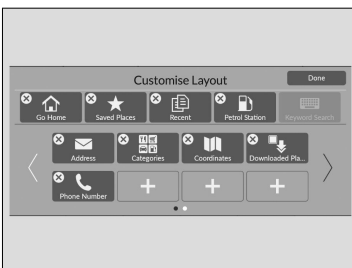

Traffic Information*

When you set the traffic feature, the system examines traffic conditions and optimizes the route for the shortest time. If a severe traffic delay occurs while you are navigating, the system searches for a faster route. If it finds one, the system will prompt you and you can choose to accept the new route.

The system may route you through a traffic delay if a better alternative route does not exist. The delay time is added into your estimated time of arrival automatically.

Select  on the map screen.

The following options are available:

- **Nearby Traffic:** Displays the traffic flow and delays on nearby roads.
- **Traffic Along Route:** Displays the traffic flow and delays along the route.

Depending on the country, you can also use this function by connecting this navigation system to the internet via Wi-Fi device.

Registering and Editing Home/Saved Places

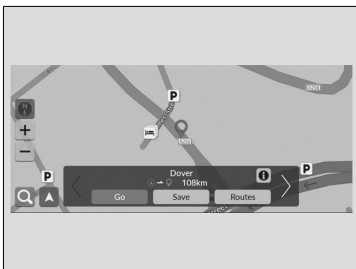

Search by Icon

You can specify a category search from Home Search, Registered Location Search, History Search, Petrol Station Search, and **More**.

Search by Keyword

You can use the search bar to search for locations by entering a category, name, address, intersection (Street 1/Street 2), city name, or state name.

After entering the desired keyword, select , select your desired location from the candidate locations and then select **Go**.

Search by Address

You can search by city or postcode and also can switch between countries by Country Name on the screen.

-  Postcode search may not be available depending on the country.
-  If your city is not listed, it may be part of a larger metropolitan area. Try entering the street first.

Search by Latitude and Longitude

You can search by entering latitude and longitude.

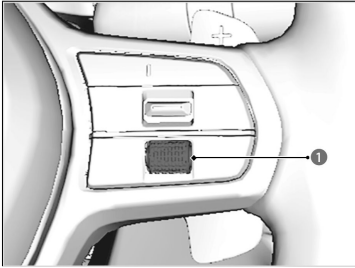

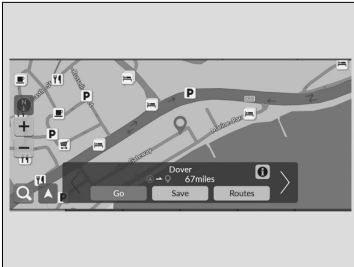

After selecting **Navigation** on the Driver Information Interface using the Right Selector Wheel (1) on the steering wheel, the **Go home**, **Saved places**, **Recent**, or **Cancel route** functions can be used.

- **i** : Displays detailed location information.
- **[Phone Icon]** : Makes a call to the displayed phone number. You need to pair your phone to the system to select the option.

Setting/Editing Waypoints

Adding Waypoints

Add waypoints (pit stops) along the route to your destination.

- [3] Select **Waypoint**.

» Select **New Route** to set the location as your new destination.

Stop the route guidance and remove the destination and all waypoints.

Taking a Detour

Calculate a new route to avoid something ahead of you. The system creates a new route if possible and attempts to get you back on your original route as quickly as possible.

Entering a New Destination

Enter a new destination using the destination menu screen even when you are en route.

[1] Select a search method to enter a new destination.

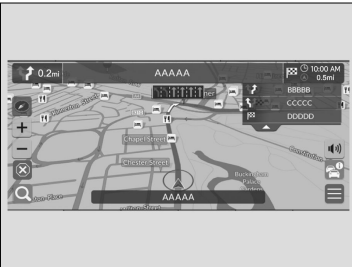

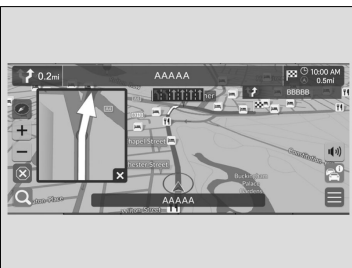

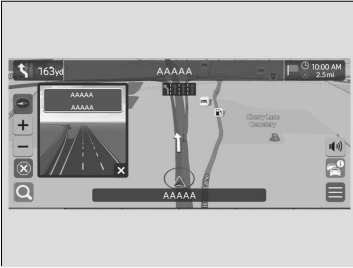


The turn information screen displays the turn on the map and the distance remaining before you reach the turn. The lane assist screen may display a view of the upcoming intersection.

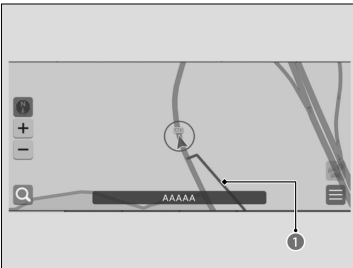

Voice Recognition

Your vehicle has a voice control system that allows hands-free operation of the navigation system functions.

The voice control system uses the  (Talk) button on the steering wheel and a microphone near the map lights on the ceiling.

The languages that the voice control system recognises are English, German, French, Spanish, and Italian.

Voice Control Operation

- [1] Press and release the  (Talk) button on the steering wheel to display the Voice Portal screen. The system beeps when ready for a command.
 - » Pressing the  (Talk) button twice will immediately put the system into the command accepting state.
 - » Press the  (Back) button or say  “Cancel” to cancel.
- [2] Say  “Navigation.”
- [3] Listen for the voice prompt, then say a voice command.

Problem	Solution
The navigation system reboots by itself (returns to the opening screen).	A reboot can be caused by extreme temperatures or shock from bumpy roads, and does not necessarily indicate a problem. If this happens frequently, please see your dealer.
How do I report new streets, landmarks, etc. that are not incorporated in the map data?	For reporting issues with the database or places/landmarks: Visit https://mapcreator.here.com/mapcreator For details, refer to the Help pages of the website.
No traffic icon or traffic information is displayed.	Verify the following: Check that the traffic icons are turned on.  Traffic Information* ▶ P.22 Online services may be off. Please enable Online Services .  Online Services ▶ P.13
The location of my vehicle displayed on the map screen is not correct.	The signal reception can easily be interrupted or interfered with by electronic devices mounted near the navigation unit, tall buildings, motorway overpasses, tunnels, etc.
My clock frequently changes forward and backward by one hour.	The clock setting is automatically updated based on your GPS location. If you are driving near a time zone border, the automatic update likely is the reason.
Does the navigation system work outside coverage area?	The system contains maps for the Albania, Andorra, Austria, Azores Islands, Balearic Islands, Belarus, Belgium, Bosnia/Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Canary Islands (Gran Canaria / Tenerife), Channel Islands, Ceuta, Croatia, Cyprus, Czech, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, French Guiana, Germany, Gibraltar, Greece, Guadeloupe, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Isle of Man, Israel, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, North Macedonia, Madeira, Malta, Martinique, Moldova, Monaco, Morocco, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Reunion, Romania, Saint Bartheleme, San Marino, Serbia/Montenegro/Kosovo, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey, United Kingdom, and Ukraine.
